Seminar participants who have USTU referee certification may retain this accreditation and apply it as credit toward attaining their next higher level within the USA Taekwondo certification structure.

This seminar is open to black belts, age 16 and over. Seminar attendance is limited to 40.

The seminar will take place from 10 am to 6 pm. Lunch will be provided. Dress code is Taekwondo uniform. Please bring notepad and pen to take notes.

To apply for the seminar, please submit the enclosed application, a copy of your USTU referee certification, and application fee of \$60.
