**Subject: 27<sup>th</sup> Annual US Central Open Taekwondo Championships**

**To: All Masters, Instructors, and Students**

I am pleased to announce the upcoming 27<sup>th</sup> Annual US Central Open Taekwondo Championship to be held **August 11, 2018** at Del City High School in Del City, OK! Come be a part of this great tournament - now one of the biggest summer Taekwondo tournaments in the central United States.

All Poomsae, Fighting, and Special Events competition will consist of a maximum of 4 competitors per division. We will also award a **Poomsae Grand Champion** this year again. To qualify for this competition, competitors must place 1<sup>st</sup> in their normal Poomsae division. In total, there will be ten Poomsae Grand Champion divisions. Only the first-place winner in each division will receive an extraordinarily beautiful trophy.

This year we will be introducing a new event! All competitors will have the opportunity to compete in a new event many black belts are familiar with: one-minute double roundhouse kicks. Competitors will have **one minute** to do as many double roundhouse kicks on a standing bag as they can. Kicks will be counted by a judge, referee, or official. First, second, and third place will be awarded to the top competitors in each division for this event. All color belt divisions will be divided by age only. Black belts will compete separately by age.

Each school that pre-registers ten or more competitors will be presented with a **team award**.

At this tournament, we are offering Masters and Instructors the opportunity to participate for **free in any one event**. This offer is only for the owner of each school who also brings competitors from their school.

Please help support our tournament with qualified judges and referees. Each judge/referee will receive a **\$40 pension** and an appreciation plaque for their full day of service. Referees can also compete for **free in one event**, Poomsae or Special Event. Referees who compete for free will not receive the pension, but they will still receive the appreciation plaque.

Masters and Instructors who are traveling out of state will be reimbursed for their hotel stay. Look for further information regarding hotel stay and tournament details in a forthcoming package and visit <http://www.gmwons.com>.
