NOTES

- **1.** All Taekwondo forms are acceptable in form competition.
- 2. Forms and Fighting division may be combined with one rank/age higher or lower if there are less than four competitors in a division.
- **3.** There will be maximum 4 competitors per division.
- **4.** Fighting divisions will be divided by weight.
- **5.** For breaking competitors, boards are available for purchase at the door. Hanmadang events must buy boards at the event to ensure same for all competitors. Please bring volunteer board holders. Equipment may be available/limited.

SPECIAL EVENTS

- **1. Breaking:** A) Power; B) Technical Scoring Criteria
 - a. Difficulty of Technique
 - **b.** Number of boards
 - c. Technique will be based on Accuracy, Speed, & Power
 - **d.** The maximum time to complete the performance is 1 min
- Poomsae: A) Couples; B) Team Forms (3+ competitors);
 C) Creative or Musical Poomsae; D) Family Poomsae
- 3. Weapons (gumdo, nunchucks, bow staff, etc.)
- **4. Double Roundhouse Bag Kicks** (alternating legs) & **single roundhouse kicks** (30 sec right leg, 30 sec left leg)
- **5. Para (Special Needs):** Forms and Special Events Only

HANMADANG SPECIAL EVENTS*

- 1. Knife Hand Power Breaking
- 2. Side/Back Kick Power Breaking
 - a. For knife, side, and back kick breaking, whoever breaks the most # of boards wins.
 - b. There should be no space between the boards
 - c. Boards must be purchased here at the event (to ensure fairness of quality).
- 3. Speed Spin Hook Kick
 - a. 20 seconds
 - b. Most number of board breaks wins.
- 4. Jumping High Kick
 - a. Highest snap kick board break wins.
 - b. May divide participants by rank, height, &/or age.
- 5. Self Defense Individual: 1.5-2 min to 2
- 6. Self-Defense Group
- 7. Team Demo

Hanmadang events must buy boards at the event to ensure same for all competitors.

AWARDS:

Kyorugi, Poomsae, & Special Events:

1st, 2nd, and two 3rd places receive a large, beautiful trophy.

COMPETITION RULES:

USATaekwondo and AAU rules.

ELIMINATIONS:

All belts 3 rounds (1 min. each). Winner of 2 out of 3 rounds is winner (as per new rules).

TEAM AWARDS:

Top 10 schools with the most competitors (minimum 11 competitors) will receive a special team award.

SPECIAL NOTICES:

- Coach fee will be waived for one Headmaster OR Instructor per school. \$35 fee for additional coaches (late fee at the door +\$25).
- 2. Lunch & dinner will be provided to all Officials, Referees, and Volunteers.
- 3. All Referees will receive a special award.
- 4. Long-distance Master/Instructors will be reimbursed \$100 each night for hotel stay depending on number of competitors attending:

 8+ competitors = 1 night

15+ competitors = 2 nights

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Fist, forearm, shin & instep.
- 2. Protective cup (males).
- 3. Mouthpiece (all fighting competitors).
- 4. Chest protector and head gear.
- 5. All black belts ages 10 & up who are sparring must have Daedo E-socks.
